Overview

The lastminute.com Talking Phrasebooks are a series of podcasts with a difference! Once installed onto your iPod, each language will provide spoken translations for approximately 800 words and phrases that transform your iPod into a portable, talking translator.

Downloading and installing the phrasebooks is easy and once you have done so you'll be speaking like a local in no time!

There are six languages available (French, German, Greek, Italian, Portuguese and Spanish) and you may have any combination of the phrasebooks running on your iPod at any time.

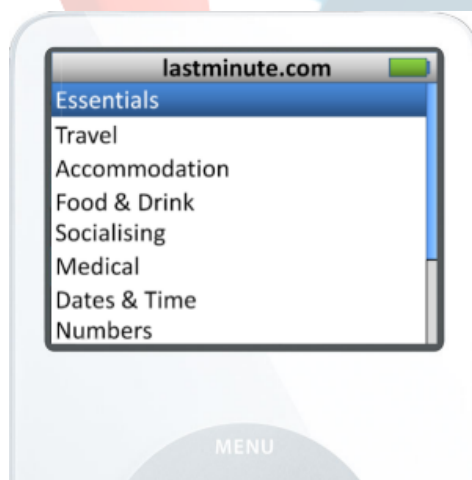
Before you get started, it will help if you understand a little about how the phrasebooks work.

Podcasts

Each language has its own podcast which once downloaded provide approximately 800 audio translations. You can access the translations just like any other podcast although the phrasebooks have been designed to be used with your iPods "Notes" feature.

Installation Wizard

The installation wizard installs a familiar phrasebook menu system on your iPod which is accessed via your iPod's "Notes" feature. From here you can select your required phrases from sections such as Travel, Accommodation, Food & Drink and Socialising. There is even a Dictionary section which provides hundred of useful words to help improve your vocabulary.

System Requirements

To use the phrasebooks as intended you should have the following;

1. An iPod that supports the “Notes” feature
2. Windows XP, Windows Vista, Mac OS X v10.4 or 10.5
3. iTunes Version 7.3.1 or later
4. 30mb of free space on your iPod (per language)
5. 1 GB of system memory (recommended minimum)
6. 1.8Ghz processor (recommended minimum)
7. 512kbps internet connection (recommended minimum)

Checking compatibility

“Notes” Feature

To use this podcast as intended you should have an iPod that supports the “Notes” feature. If you are unsure as to if your iPod supports this feature it easy to find out.

With the exception of the iPod Touch and iPhone, if your iPod has a dock connector as shown below, it will also have the “Notes” reader function. From your iPod’s main menu select “Extras” and from there you will see “Notes”.

Windows installation instructions

1. “Subscribe” and “Get All” the Podcast episodes from iTunes

Subscribe: If you haven't done so already, you need to “**Subscribe**” to your required language’s podcast in order to download the sound files onto your iPod. The following links will open iTunes and take you the individual languages.

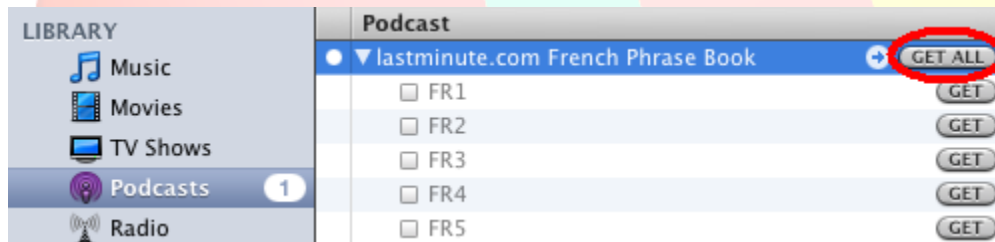

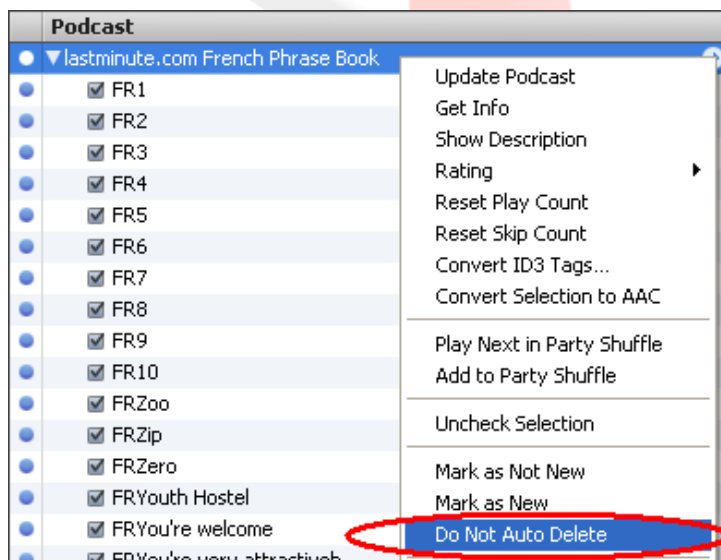

Get All: Once you have subscribed, select “Podcasts” from the Library menu on the left hand side and click on the arrow next to the podcast title so that it points down as shown below. Now click on “**Get All**” and iTunes will begin to download all the episodes in the podcast.

Since there are approximately 800 episodes please be patient. Depending on the speed of your computer and internet connection, this may take 5 – 15 minutes to complete.



IMPORTANT: Once iTunes has finished downloading all the episodes of the podcast right click on the podcast header and select **Do Not Auto Delete**. This will prevent iTunes from deleting any phrases you have listened to next time you sync your iPod.



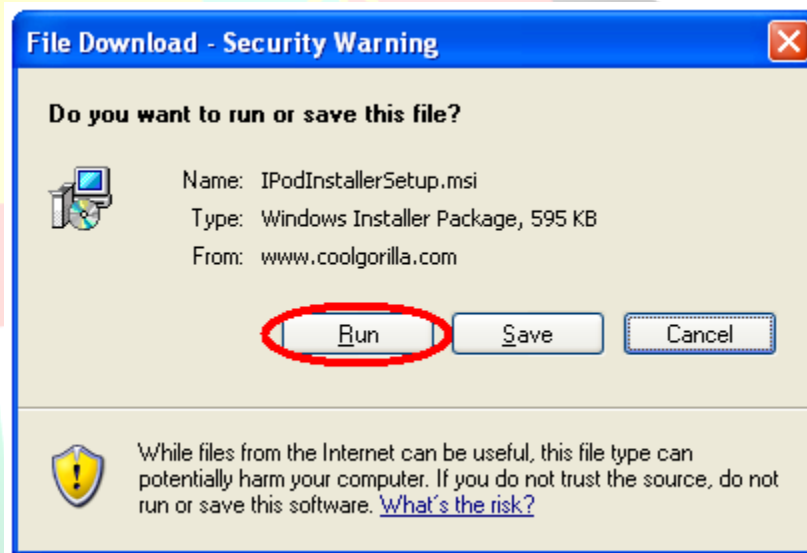

2. Run the Installation Wizard

Now all you need to do is download and run the Installation Wizard that will provides the phrasebook menu system in your iPod's "Notes" feature.

To start the download **CLICK HERE**.

Select "Run" and then follow the instructions on screen.



IMPORTANT: The Installation Wizard works with every language and so if you wish to use more than one phrasebook at a time, you only need to download the Wizard once.

3. Finishing Off

Finally, to ensure that the podcast is on your iPod and not just in iTunes make sure you have synced your iPod with iTunes. Then you can eject your iPod and your ready to try out some French!

To access the phrase book from your iPod, go to the main menu screen of your iPod and select "**Extras**" and then "**Notes**" and you will see the language you have just installed.

Mac Installation Instructions

1. “Subscribe” and “Get All” the Podcast episodes from iTunes

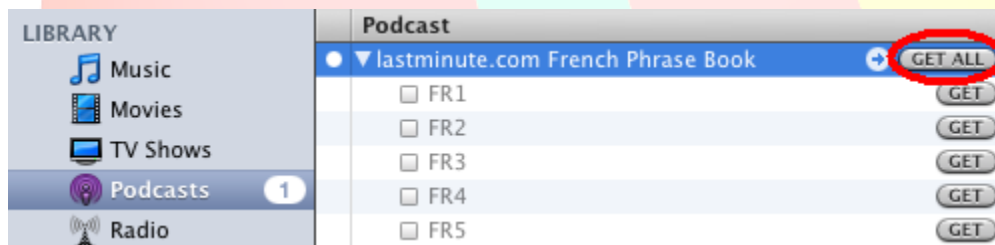

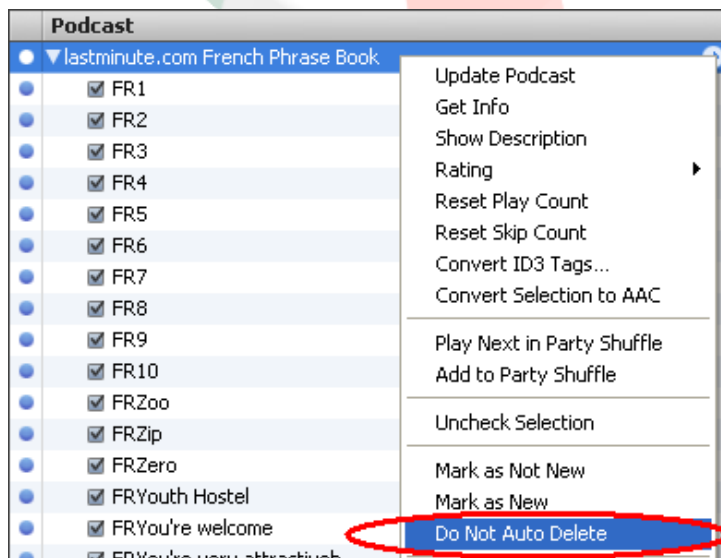

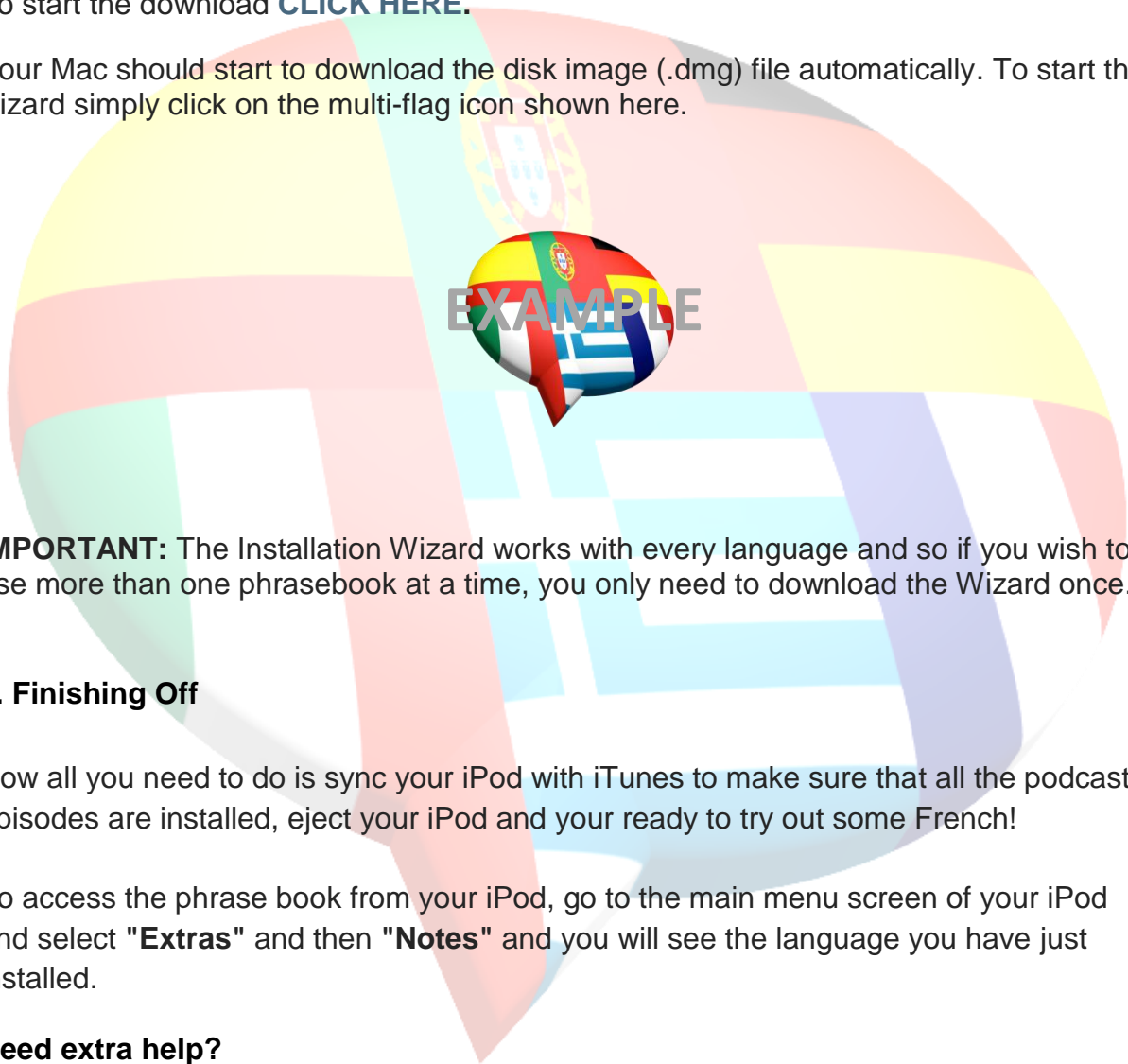

2. Download the Installation Wizard

Your Mac should start to download the disk image (.dmg) file automatically. To start the wizard simply click on the multi-flag icon shown here.



IMPORTANT: The Installation Wizard works with every language and so if you wish to use more than one phrasebook at a time, you only need to download the Wizard once.

3. Finishing Off

Now all you need to do is sync your iPod with iTunes to make sure that all the podcast episodes are installed, eject your iPod and your ready to try out some French!

To access the phrase book from your iPod, go to the main menu screen of your iPod and select "**Extras**" and then "**Notes**" and you will see the language you have just installed.

FAQs

Q. Where is the “Notes” feature on my iPod.

A. Unless you have customised your iPod’s menu setting you will find the “Notes” feature in “Extras”.

Q. How do I know if my iPod has the notes feature?

A. With the exception of the iPod Touch and iPhone, if your iPod has a dock connector as shown below, it will also have the “Notes” reader function. From your iPod’s main menu select “Extras” and from there you will see “Notes”.

Q. I have an iPhone / iPod touch what should I do?

A. Visit www.coolgorilla.com/iphone

Q. The Installation Wizard asked me to “Enable for disk use”. What does this mean?

A. Your iPod can act just like a USB storage device and this is achieved by selecting the option “Enable for disk use”. To run the Talking Phrasebooks it is necessary that this setting has been selected. To find out more about using your iPod as a storage drive visit apples website [HERE](#).

Q. Are there other languages available?

A. Currently French, German, Greek, Italian, Portuguese and Spanish are the six available languages.

Q. I can't hear anything / I'm not hearing the translations.

A. The most likely cause of this is that you have not synced your iPod since you downloaded the relevant podcast. Try syncing your iPod to iTunes again.

Q. Why do certain phrases not play anymore?

A. The most likely cause of this is not selecting **"Do not auto delete"** in iTunes once having downloaded the podcast. To solve this re-download the podcast, sync your iPod and make sure you follow the installation instructions properly this time!

Q. I'm having trouble downloading the podcast.

A. Make sure that you are not running any other programs other than iTunes and that your internet connection is working properly. If you are using a wireless internet connection please make sure that you have a strong signal. When selecting **"Get All"** you may find that your computer takes some time before commencing to download all the episodes. This is perfectly normal. Once you have selected **"Get All"** leave your computer until it has finished downloading all the episodes.
